

## Naming of AINS Foal Tako Kichi



The chestnut filly, N2BHS-AIOU, is now the newly coined "Tako Kichi". Congratulations to Jo-Ann Rasmussen (MD) who held the winning ticket in the Name That Foal fundraising raffle. She chose the name Tako Kichi for its loose Japanese translation, kite crazy, in honor of the kite flying hobby she shares with her spouse, Rich Miller. In her own words, Jo-Ann shares what this naming opportunity and their passion for kite flying have meant to the pair.

"Tako Kichi is a phrase that is used world-wide, especially by those in the international kiting community, referring to those who are passionate about kites and kite flying. My husband and I have been involved in kiting for over 40-plus years, we describe it as a "hobby out of control" as it started with just one small kite and grew. We have a collection of kites from all over the world, from miniature kites to ones that are 50+ feet long, and many that Rich has made including our band of "Assateague Sky Ponies" that represent several Assateague horses including Annie Laurie, Autumn Glory, Charcoal, and Coco, a few generic horses, unicorns, Pegasus, merhorses (hippocampus), and there will soon be a Tako Kichi sky pony.

We have enjoyed visiting Assateague for several decades, enjoying nature and participating in a variety of activities including kayaking, biking and hiking. However, Assateague Island National Seashore has become one of our favorite places to fly kites and to share our favorite hobby with others. Talking with other park visitors is one of our favorite things to do while flying kites. Kites are a way to "break the ice", meet other people and put a smile on someone's face. It's fun to launch a pile of fabric, watch it take shape in the breeze and hear children yelling out with enthusiasm what they think it is...a cat, horse, whale, dragon, turtle, etc. There are also many other "kiters" enjoying the island, from children running with and flying a simple toy kite, kite boarders & kite surfers jumping waves or sailing along the coast, Kite Aerial Photography enthusiasts capturing bird's eye views of the island, kayakers sailing bayside using a kite/ wind power, campers flying kites anchored to their RV's as a site marker and of course those that are "Tako Kichi" like us flying large show kites, art kites, and dual & quad line controlled sport/stunt kites on the beach.




## Naming of AINS Foal Tako Kichi
